

Engaging with the MIS Network

There are a number of ways you can interact with the MIS Network:

1. Sign up to the MIS mailing list

The Network maintains a mailing list which it uses to publicise notices about meetings, events and workshops. It's also a useful mechanism for members to share information with the group, as everyone has equal rights to post to the group.

To subscribe to the mailing list, visit:

www.jiscmail.ac.uk/cgi-bin/webadmin?SUBED1=SCOT-FE-MIS&A=1

Enter your name and email address, select your subscription type:

- Regular (receive emails as soon as they're posted to the list)
- Digest (receive a single email which contains all the emails posted on that day)

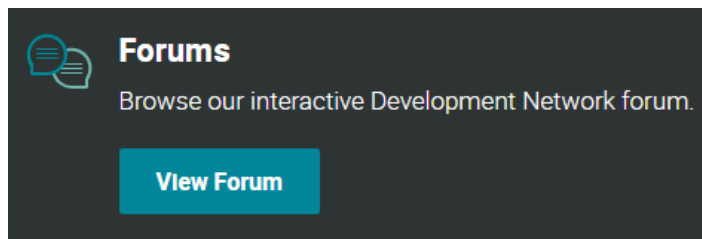
If you wish to unsubscribe from the list, send an email to listserv@jiscmail.ac.uk with the following command in the body of your message (no subject line is necessary):

```
unsubscribe SCOT-FE-MIS Yourfirstname Yourlastname
```

Note, you have to send this message from the email account that is subscribed to the list.

2. Use the MIS website forum

On the CDN website, you will find an area at the bottom of the [MIS Network page](#) which links to an online forum where you can post messages to the group.



Note, you will need to register for an account on the CDN site before you can post to the forum.

3. Attend an MIS event

The MIS Network runs a series of events through the year. You can receive direct notifications of these events via the mailing list (see above), looking at CDN's event pages at: <http://cdn.ac.uk/courses-resources>
