Example of First Aid Treatments	
Eye Contact:	Rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
Skin Contact:	Flush skin with soap and water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention immediately.
Ingestion:	Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention immediately.
Inhalation:	Remove casualty from exposure to fresh air. Seek medical assistance immediately.
