

## CDN Online Learning



College Development Network has created a way for you to get recognition for participating in professional development activities related to inclusive practice.

Completion of relevant activities generates Inclusive Practitioner credits. Accumulate 20 Inclusive Practitioner credits to be awarded a certificate and Open Badge. This can be used to evidence your status as an Inclusive Practitioner.

Listed here are some examples of activities in the Inclusive Practitioner programme. Opening an Inclusive Practitioner account is optional – you can also undertake all these activities as standalone learning experiences. All are fully funded, so there are no fees to pay.

### Understanding the Role of the Support Worker

**Online course.** Successful completion of the reflective activities and Knowledge Check generates 4 credits and a CPD certificate or Open Badge in Understanding the Role of the Support Worker.

### Promoting Positive Behaviour in the Classroom

**Online course.** Successful completion of the Knowledge Check generates 6 credits and a CPD certificate or Open Badge in Promoting Positive Behaviour in the Classroom.

### Student Mental Health

**Online course.** Successful completion of the optional knowledge check and assignment generates 6 credits and a CPD certificate or Open Badge in Student Mental Health.

### Including Students who are Deaf, Visually Impaired, or Deafblind (DVIDB)

**Online course.** Successful completion of the reflective exercise generates 6 credits and a CPD certificate or Open Badge in Including Students who are Deaf, Visually Impaired, or Deafblind.
