Practitioner credits. Accumulate 20 Inclusive Practitioner credits to

Listed here are some examples of activities in the Inclusive Practitioner programme. More are in development. Opening an Inclusive Practitioner account is optional – you can also undertake all these activities as standalone learning experiences. All are fully funded, so there are no fees to pay.

Online course. Successful completion of the reflective activities and Knowledge Check generates 4 credits and a CPD certificate or Open Badge in Understanding the Role of the Support

Collaborative Working in Sensory Support

Event. Participate on the day and complete a short, post-event online reflective task to achieve 4 Inclusive Practitioner credits.

Promoting Positive Behaviour in the Classroom

Online course. Successful completion of the Knowledge Check generates 6 credits and a CPD certificate or Open Badge in Promoting Positive Behaviour in the Classroom.

Needs Assessor Update Series

Webinars. Participation in one Needs Assessor Update webinar generates 1 credit. To obtain the credit complete the evaluation emailed to you after the webinar.
