- Working abroad.

CDN will do that by:

- Setting up an Interest Group that will act as an Ambassador Programme
- Organising regional information sessions and webinars
- Holding a national conference in Glasgow in September 2017.

The CDN International Development Network is supported by the British Council, it acts as a forum for professional updates and sharing information and advice across the college sector. The Network also encourages and supports collaborative bids and projects.

Our **Erasmus+ Interest Group and Ambassador Programme** will work closely with the International Development Network, which will be able to feed in relevant information and experiences.

Throughout 2017 we will be running **regional workshops** in colleges across Scotland, to highlight the benefits offered by an Erasmus+ experience and to provide information on what's involved when applying.
