Fields of practice: Adult Nursing, Children's Nursing, Learning Disability Nursing, Mental Health Nursing.



NURSING DEGREE ROUTE

APPLICANTS:

Anyone with the relevant qualifications can apply, including school pupils, college students, mature student career changers and assistant practitioners.
Time: 3 to 4 years

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Entry requirements vary but you are likely to need 3 SQA Highers at grade C or SCQF Level 6 equivalent plus supporting National 5 Qualifications in English and Maths or SCQF Level 5 equivalent.

12 universities provide nursing degrees across Scotland.

Bursaries are available and course fees are paid by Scottish Government.

HNC CARE AND ADMINISTRATIVE PRACTICE (CAP) ROUTE

APPLICANTS:

Healthcare support workers and individuals who do not have the required qualifications for direct entry into university programmes.
Time: 3 to 4 years

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

2 SQA Highers or SCQF Level 6 equivalent.

Successful learners may go directly into 2nd year university studies.

23 colleges in Scotland provide HNC CAP qualification.

Course funding available depending on application.

SCOTTISH WIDER ACCESS PROGRAMME (SWAP) ROUTE

APPLICANTS:

Adult learners who have been out of education for 3 or more years.
Time: 4 years

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

None.

Tuition fees and a bursary may be available.

RETURN TO NURSING PRACTICE

APPLICANTS:

Former qualified nurses.
Time: Up to 6 months

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Statement of Entry confirming previous registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council.

This is a practice based course.
Funding for course fees may be available.

THE OPEN UNIVERSITY ROUTE

APPLICANTS:

Healthcare support workers.
Time: 4 years part-time

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

SCQF level 5 numeracy and literacy or OU 'Access to Nursing' - no formal qualifications required.

Remain employed in existing post while studying nursing degree.

Online learning with placements locally.

Scottish Government pay course fees.
