FLEXIBLE LEARNING OPTIONS

Offer flexible learning options such as part-time, online, or evening classes to accommodate the schedules of adult learners who may be juggling work, family, and other responsibilities.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

Acknowledge and give credit for the knowledge and skills acquired through work experience or other non-traditional avenues, especially for adult learners returning to college.

TAILORED SUPPORT SERVICES

Provide support services that cater to the unique needs of different age groups, including academic advising, counseling, and career services tailored to traditional and non-traditional students.

INTERGENERATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Facilitate intergenerational activities and events that encourage interaction and collaboration between students of different age groups. This can foster a sense of community and mutual understanding.
