- 1. Educate Staff and Students:

- 2. Promote Inclusivity and Respect:

  - Intervene: When you hear discriminatory remarks, interrupt and educate to create a safer environment.

  - Safe Space: Create a safe space where students feel comfortable coming out.
  - Responding: Be prepared to respond empathetically when students disclose their LGBTQ+ identity.
