The programme provides support and continuing professional development to board members of Scottish colleges and all those involved with college governance.

About the Programme

The CDN National College Governance Programme provides support to College Board Members and Governance Professionals. The programme has been developed to provide a full range of continuing professional development activities from inductions for new Board Members to training and guidance in specific areas of governance.

CDN also provides in-person training for boards and a range of bespoke support. This is listed in the table below.

Board Induction Refresher	Short (45 minute) session that can be delivered as part of a board meeting or development day that covers the key responsibilities of board members, the Code of Good Governance and other guidance and the key principles of college governance.	
Understanding Quality	Half day workshop to help board members understand their role in academic quality assurance and the new Tertiary Quality Enhancement Framework (TQEF).	
Developing a High-Performing Board*	Full day workshop focusing on the development of high-performing boards by supporting board members to engage with the principles of strategic leadership in high stakes scenarios.	
Managing Conflict*	Half day workshop to help board members understand some of the causes and impact of conflict and how it escalates and how to use a number of tools used in mediation to resolve conflict.
