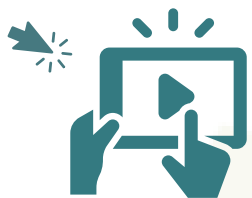

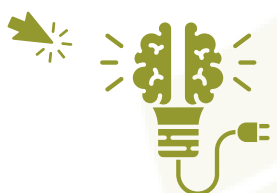
Watch: An interview with Jane Elliot as she describes the first time she administered her legendary test: the original Brown Eye/ Blue Eye test.

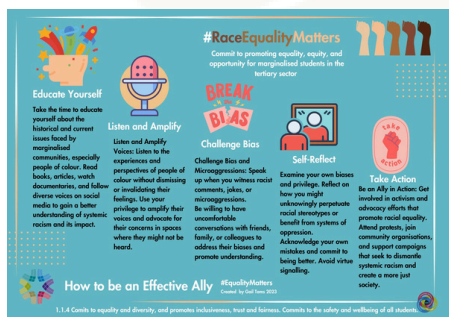
Listen: The Anti-Racist Educator podcast from a collective of educators of colour. There are 16 episodes in total.
